- 1 million fly-tipping incidents each year
 - 50% are household waste
 - £50million each year for local authorities
- Around 400 illegal site controlled
 - closed or now in regulation
- 50% of export containers illegal

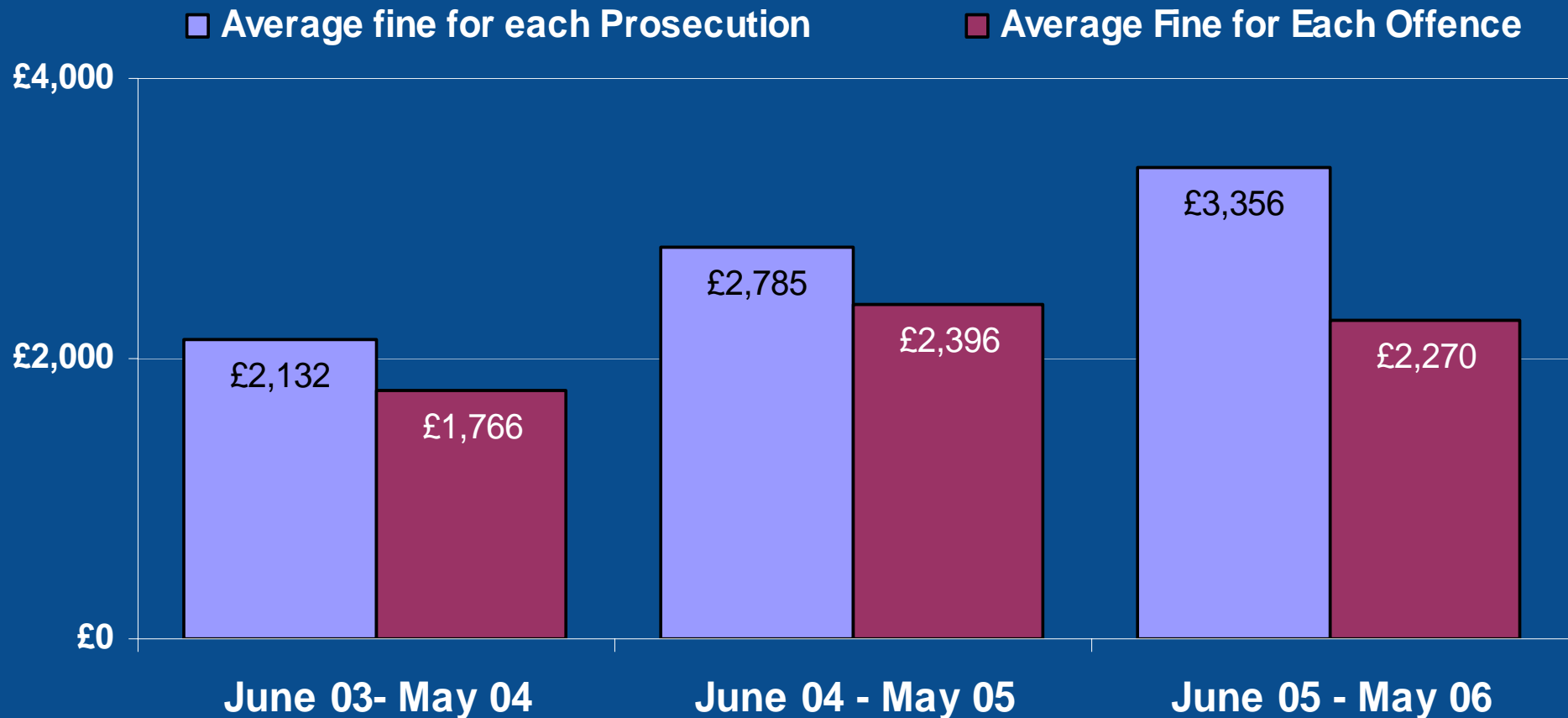
